



Meal Delivery or Pickup Enrollment Form

Whitley County School Nutrition participates in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs. For children enrolled in the Whitley County Schools, we can provide a breakfast and lunch meal free of charge each scheduled school day. Currently federal regulations require us to run our program like we would during the school year not like the Summer Feeding Program. Only students enrolled and participating in learning daily are eligible for free meals. The students must be utilizing NTI packets or online learning each day to receive meals.

School Nutrition is partnering with Transportation to deliver meals from August 26 through September 25, 2020. The buses will run their regular routes Monday through Friday. Buses will leave the schools at 2:30 p.m. to begin delivering meals.

To receive the meals, you **MUST** enroll. You can have meals delivered to your child's regular bus stop or another bus stop on the route or you can pick up the meals instead.

If you want to pick up the meals, you may pick up each scheduled school day from 12:00 p.m. until 1:30 p.m. at participating schools. You can only receive meals one time a day and at your chosen site either delivered or picked up.
